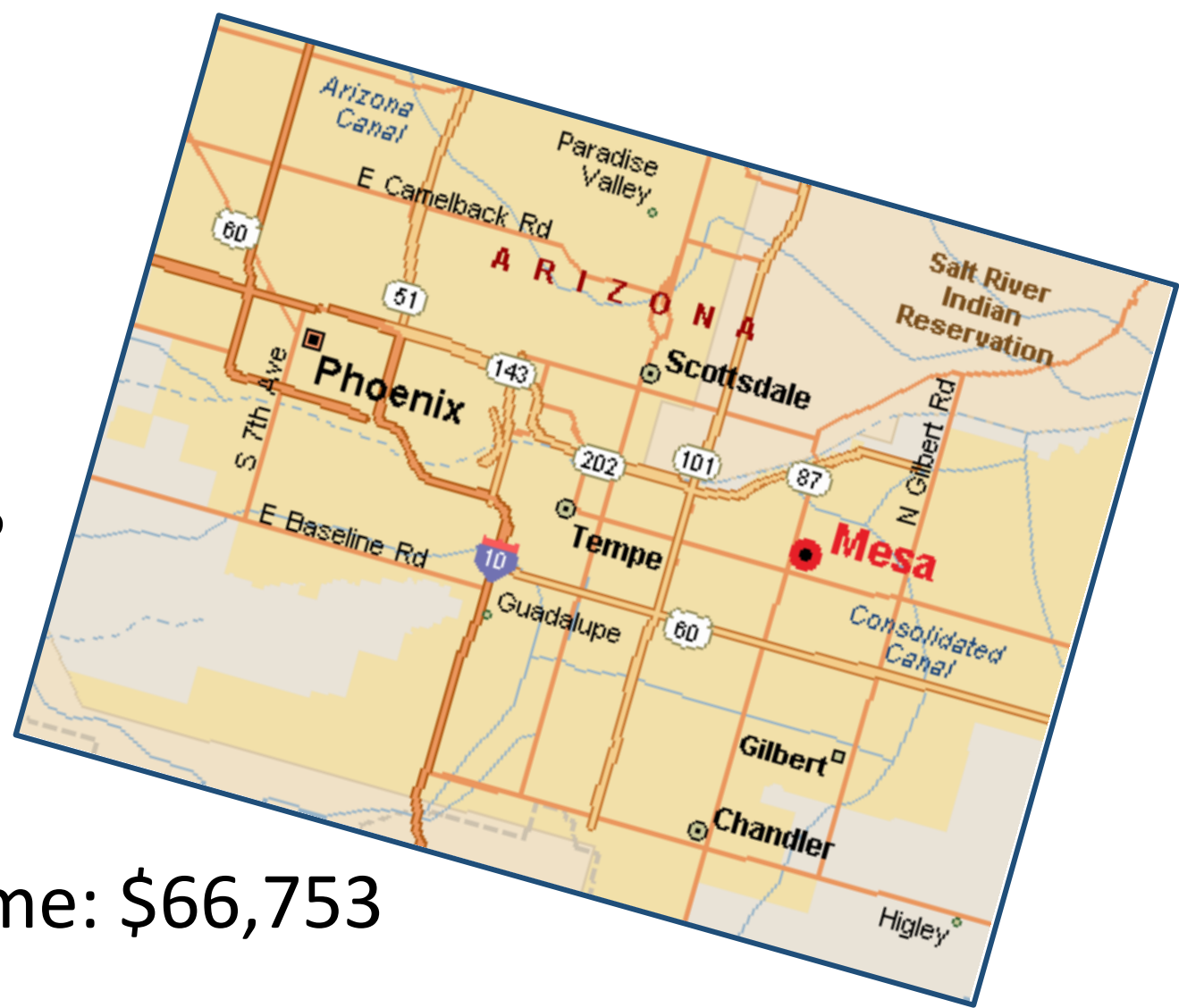

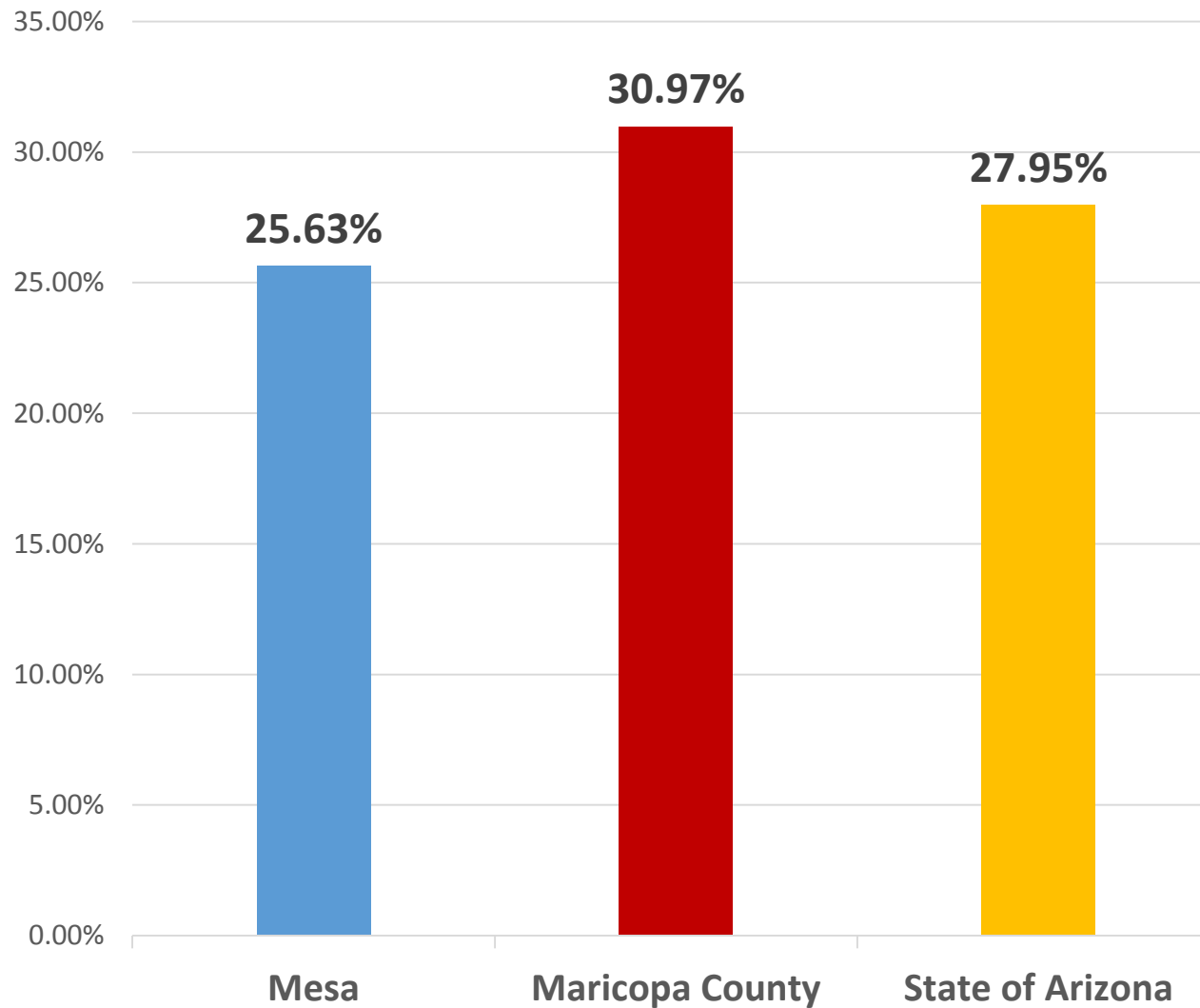

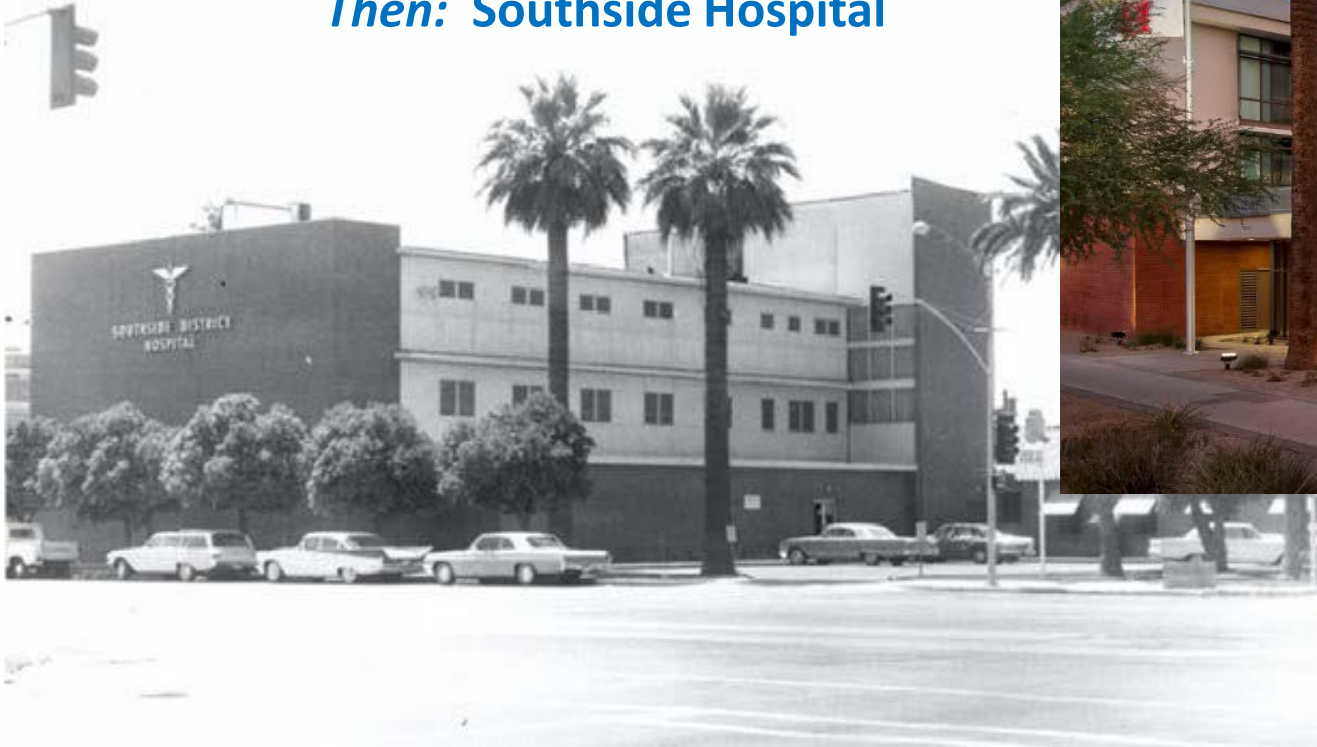

The Investment

- City invested more than **\$17 million** to renovate three vacant, city-owned buildings in Downtown Mesa.
- **85,000 sq. ft.** of unused space converted into state-of-the-art educational facilities.

Created **60 net new full-time jobs**
(college and university faculty & staff)



Contributed more than **\$6.5 million**
of **new private investment**;
City invested \$17 million

Occupied **85,000+/- sq ft**
of long-term vacant space

Enrolled **530 students**
on campuses

\$2.5M in scholarship funding
per year



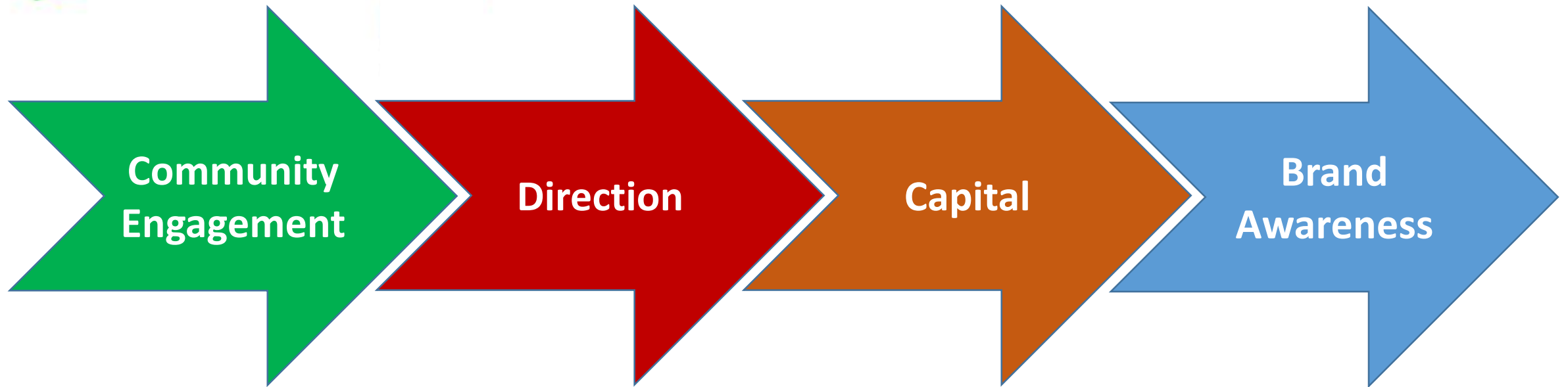
BenU generates approximately
