

Metro areas with at least 100,000 population were assessed on their concentration of full-time STEM workforce, advanced degree or science & engineering undergraduate degree holders and net business formation





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

Gross Domestic Product





Ranking Methodology Overall Ranking

The overall global ecosystem ranking is a weighted average of the following factor scores:

Performance: 30%

Funding: 20%

Market Reach: 12.5%

Connectedness: 12.5%

Talent: 10%

Experience: 10%

Knowledge: 5%

Ranking Details

Performance

Captures the actual leading, current, and lagging indicators of ecosystem performance.

- 40% Ecosystem Value = log of sum of all exits and estimated startups valuations during the timeframe without double-counting
- 30% Exits
 - 80% Volume of Exits (80% log of number of exits of \$50M+ and 20% number of exits of \$1B+)
 - 20% Exit Growth Index (scored from 1 to 10))


