- Average employment growth rate 14% for a total of more than 14,000 new jobs

Preparing Small Business Leaders for Growth

Intensive entrepreneurial training in a peer group setting accelerates the growth of high-potential small businesses.

In 50 Communities and Growing

- 7 month intensive training
- Businesses develop custom 3 year growth plan
- Graduates saw an improved bottom line & increased revenue on average by \$362,000, a 39% growth rate after one year

Strengthening Innovation and Competitiveness

Industry-focused centers in a dozen communities connect small businesses with the local entrepreneurial ecosystem through intensive networking, training and advising.

In the past three years, participating businesses

- Grew at an annualized rate of 18%
- Obtained contracts totaling approximately \$602 m
- Received federal Small Business Innovation Research and Small Business Technology Transfer (SBIR/STTR) funding totaling \$24 million
